

State Officers Nomination Guide Lines

Taken from State By-Laws

Section 12 – Candidates for State Board Officers

The county submitting the name of the candidate shall send two copies of the qualification, one to the chairman of the nominating committee and the second to the secretary of the association.

A letter of recommendation from the county council shall accompany the qualification of the candidate.

A voting delegate wishing to make a nomination from the floor shall provide the nominating committee chairman with a copy of qualifications of the candidate prior to the nomination.

The nominating committee chairman shall make a list of individuals qualifying for offices to be kept on file by the secretary.

In the event that an officer is unable to complete a term of office due to sufficient cause, they may be reelected. A term of office is considered more the one month over half of a term.

A past president may not be elected to any office on the state board until after one term of office has elapsed. They may serve in an appointed position.
